I travelled with another family as they embraced the bold step of homeownership in the City of Newburgh. Now I would be less than truthful if I said any of these experiences were easy as the Executive Director (nor do I imagine that they were for the rest of the staff and volunteers). Yet, the unwavering belief and commitment of our homeowners to complete their homeownership journey fostered not only a sense of hope for themselves, but for all of us journeying with them
