Furniture

- Dressers, night stands, end tables, coffee tables, kitchen & dining tables, chairs, buffets, bookshelves, desks, and drafting tables
- Upholstered items in excellent to new condition: sofas, recliners, love seats, chairs, ottomans, and area rugs. NO rips, pet hair, smoke odor, or fading will be accepted.

Appliances

 Gently used and clean: refrigerators, freezers, cook tops, microwaves, washing machines, dryers, stoves, range hoods, air conditioners, dehumidifiers and vacuums. Appliances must be in full and complete working order and less than 10 years old.

Kitchen and Bath Cabinents

- Clean cabinets and vanities
- Thoroughly cleaned sinks and toilets that are less than 10 years old
- Uncut laminate counter tops

Home Decor/Housewares/Media

- Table floor lamps
- Framed mirrors
- Seasonal holiday decor
- Pots, pans, dishes, glassware, artwork, books, records, CDs, DVDs.

Building Supplies

- Interior/exterior residential light fixtures in complete working order
- Windows & doors (gently used & new condition)
- New wood flooring and tile (at least 32 sq ft of the same product/design)
- New bathtubs & shower enclosures
- New in-the-box shower doors
- New kitchen/bath fixtures

Hardware & Tools

- Full boxes or unopened hardware
- Hand and power tools in new or good condition

Sporting Goods

• Sports equipment and adult & children's bicycles
