Habitat Newburgh is transforming neighborhoods using our anchor block approach to building. We continue our work north of Broadway, Newburgh's main thoroughfare, to connect early build sites with new ones. These new affordable homes will not only be the catalyst for new development but also foster neighborhood comradery and a sense of community. Our sites on Johnston and North Miller are well underway and will be home to five families in the coming year. Construction of four homes on South Street and four more on Third Street will begin this year. These homes will further increase the property values in the area as well as add over \$60,000 to the tax roll per year.

The journey families undertake is reflected in the improvements and construction happening in Newburgh. To date 103 families are realizing the benefits of homeownership because of our program.
